Auction Rules



General Rules

1. A bid acknowledged by the silent auction official or live auctioneer is a legal contract to purchase and pay for in full the item on the night of the Auction. In the Silent Auction, acceptance of your written bid by the silent auction official as the top bid is a legal and binding contract to purchase that Auction item.
2. All purchases are final and there will be no exchanges or refunds on items unless otherwise specifically noted in the catalog. Everything will be sold "as is." Please read carefully specifications, restrictions and limitations on all Auction items.
3. Payment in full is mandatory at the Auction. Items may be paid for by cash, check (payable to The Primary Day School), Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. The buyer is responsible for removing all items purchased from the premises at the conclusion of the Auction.
4. Unless otherwise noted, all auction items must be used within one year of the Auction, i.e., by April 26, 2019. All unspecified dates and times are subject to availability and must be mutually agreed upon by the donor and successful bidder. Winning bidder should contact the donor within 30 days of the Auction.
5. The Gala Committee reserves the right to add or withdraw items, without notice, from the Auction.
6. In the event of a dispute between bidders during the Silent Auction, the Auction Committee will determine the successful bidder.
7. Values indicated on some Auction items are estimates only and are not warranted by the school for tax purposes or for general value.
8. All resort and private vacation homes are offered to adults and minors accompanied by adults.
9. Each person issued a bid number assumes all risks and hazards related to the Auction and items obtained at the Auction. Each bidder agrees to hold harmless The Primary Day School, its elected and appointed officials, members and employees, the auctioneer, Auction organizers, sponsors and/or volunteers connected with the Auction from any liability arising therefrom.

Silent Auction Rules

1. Items offered in the Silent Auction will have Silent Auction Bid Forms corresponding to them on a nearby table. You bid on an item simply by writing your bid number on the Bid Form next to the amount you want to bid. Bids must start no lower than the stated minimum and increase by the noted bid increment. No item will be sold for less than the stated minimum bid on the Silent Auction Bid Form.
2. If you want to be sure you receive a Silent Auction item, you may write your bid number opposite the amount labeled "Guaranteed Purchase." Once a "Guaranteed Purchase" bid is made, bidding on that item is concluded. No one may bid above your "Guaranteed Purchase" price.
3. You may continue to bid on any item in the Silent Auction until the section is closed. Once the section closes, The Silent Auction Official will circle the winning bid number and amount. Any bids entered after the section closes are disregarded.

Live Auction Rules

1. The highest bidder acknowledged by the Auctioneer shall be the purchaser. In the event of a dispute between bidders, the Auctioneer shall have sole and final discretion to determine the successful bidder, or to re-offer the items in dispute.
2. If the Auctioneer determines that any opening bid is not commensurate with the value of an item offered, the Auctioneer may reject the bid and withdraw the item for sale.
3. On the "fall of the Auctioneer's hammer," title passes to the highest bidder.
4. The winning bidder must sign the Bid Form as acknowledgement of the bid, including the bidder number and the amount of the winning bid.

The amount of charitable contribution that is deductible for Federal Income Tax purposes is limited to the excess of the amount paid by the winner over the fair market value of the goods or services provided by the donor of the item. It may be difficult, if not impossible, to establish the fair market value of one-of-a-kind items, such as art work, autographed sports memorabilia, etc. In the absence of any reliable fair market value, the winning bidder may use the purchase price as the fair market value. A good-faith estimate of the fair market value of the goods or services will be included on each receipt.

Absentee Bidder Rules

1. Absentee bids must be in whole dollar amounts and received no later than 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 26, 2018.
2. You may submit an Absentee bid for Live or Silent Auction items. Bids not meeting the minimum opening bid or those received without a valid signature will not be accepted.
3. Absentee bids are subject to all auction rules. In particular, all purchases are final and there will be no exchanges or refunds on items. An Absentee bid, if the highest valid bid, is a legal contract to purchase the item(s).
4. An Auction Committee member will use his or her best efforts to bid on the requested item(s), up to the indicated maximum bid, on your behalf. This process is provided solely for the convenience of the absentee bidder, and neither the surrogate bidder, the Auction Committee, The Primary Day School, nor the donor of the requested item(s) is responsible for any liability arising from the absentee bidder process.
5. You will be notified on Monday, April 30, 2018 of the total amount of your purchase(s) and arrangements will be made for you to pick up your item(s).
6. All absentee bids will be entered prior to Friday evening's Auction. Please indicate your opening bid and the maximum bid you are willing to offer for the item(s).
